Dear Friends of LCHS,

We are delighted to present our annual report to you—our partner in saving lives—for fiscal year 2011 (July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011). The shelter continues to provide top quality care for close to 2,000 homeless and helpless animals each year and has been doing so since it was founded by caring citizens back in 1964.

This past year has not been without its challenges; an economy that continues to suffer has led to an increase in pet surrenders. Our search for an affordable and appropriate new piece of land on which to build a new, larger and more appropriate building has not yielded any viable leads yet. The original cost of the plans we commissioned from architects who specialize in designing animal shelters was about \$4.2M—and that was with the assumption that we would have been able to use the original property on Frontage Road. We want to keep the cost of the project as low as possible, as this will truly be a community-funded effort. We continue to reach out to landowners and the government to help us locate property. We would welcome your leads as well.

The good news is that in spite of people feeling a tightening of their purse strings, annual fund donations were up across the board, with generous animal lovers like you donating 22 per-

cent more this year over last. And Montana Shares workplace giving supporters increased their donations by 12 percent last year. This tells us that animal care continues to be a high priority when people consider their philanthropic goals and for that we are very grateful. Thank you!

Finally, we have to thank our dedicated staff, volunteers and Board of Directors for their compassion and commitment to helping animals. We have a strong group who put the animals first, and that is what allows us to continue to perform at the high level the community has come to expect from us. Together, we are making a difference in the lives of homeless animals. Thank you for your support this past year. We could not do it with you.

2011 Highlights

PET ADOPTION

Our on-staff dog and cat adoption counselors worked closely with potential adopters to place almost 870 animals to new homes. Anyone interested in adopting a new friend can visit the shelter, Tuesday – Friday from noon to 6pm and Saturday from noon to 4:30. Updated photos and descriptions of available animals can be found 24 hours a day on our website at www.mtlchs.org. We're also grateful for our partnerships with many local businesses who participate in our outreach animal showcase program, and with PetCo which offers homeless felines the chance to meet potential adopters through giving them a temporary home in their store. The animals are lucky to be able to count on these partners for greater exposure!

BEHAVIOR MODIFICATION TRAINING

Many people in the community are not aware that the shelter employs two professional dog trainers who work with our dogs to help correct mild behavior issues. They also work with and provide consult to owners of shelter animals, run the Feisty Fido volunteer corps and attend continuing education conferences to bring cutting edge information on dog training to the shelter's

four-legged residents. Have a question about the dog you adopted? Give them a call!

SPAY MONTANA

This mobile program travels throughout the state to bring low or no cost spay/neuter services to people who might otherwise not be able to afford the surgery. Spay/neuter is an important part of the shelter's overall commitment to animal welfare, as reducing unwanted births reduces the number of puppies and kittens that end up homeless at the shelter – or worse. Spay Montana logged thousands of miles to perform 4,502 surgeries last year, conservatively preventing a whopping 22,510 pregnancies. Funding from donors and foundations helps the program reach over 54 communities each year. All these efforts were augmented by 600 volunteers from communities throughout Montana. A huge “thank you” is due to these men and women who give of their time to help the clinics' success.

CRUELTY/ABANDONMENT CASES

The Lewis & Clark Humane Society works closely with law enforcement on animal welfare, cruelty and abandonment cases in the tri-county area. After receiving an assessment and medical care, these animals are micro-chipped, spayed/neutered

and vaccinated so they will be ready to find a new, loving home.

FOSTER CARE

Many animals arrive at the shelter too young or too sick to be placed in homes. Our dedicated foster families provide safe, loving homes to help the animals heal and grow so that they will be able to come back to the shelter, showcased, and adopted. We are very grateful to our foster parents (15 of them last year) who open their homes and their hearts to the sick and very young. We are always looking for more foster “parents,” so please call us if you can help.

MEDICAL CARE

LCHS on-staff vet techs work with our partners at The Animal Center Veterinary Clinic to assess, monitor and treat sick and wounded animals that come to the shelter in need of medical care. The Animal Center generously provides services to these animals at their cost.

VOLUNTEERS

No animal shelter could run effectively without the support of their volunteer corps – and the Lewis & Clark Humane Society is no exception. We are fortunate to count over 100 active vol-

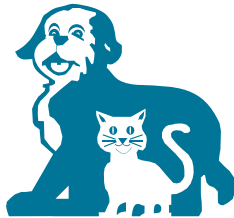

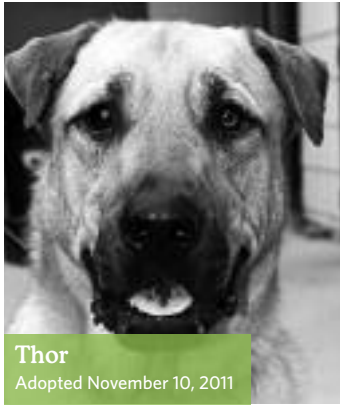
ESTATE PLANNING: MAKE A LASTING TRIBUTE

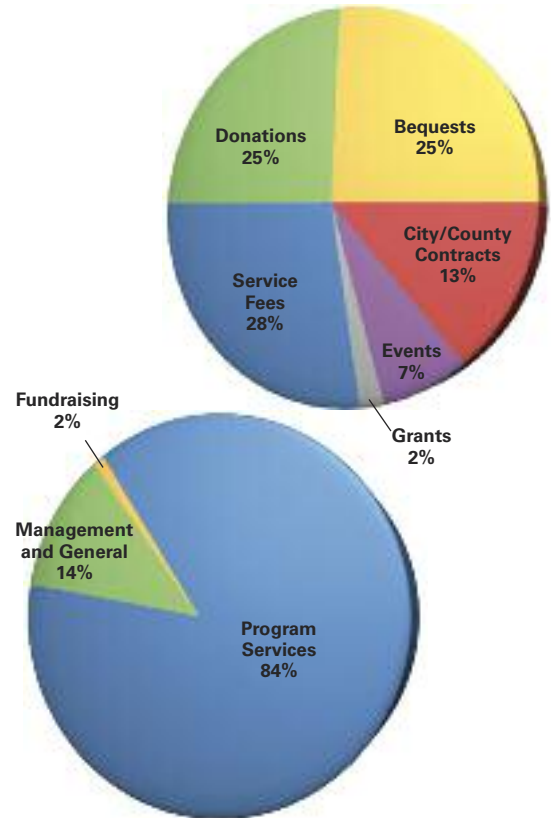
